NRTA conducts Year-Round Service Study

The Nantucket Regional Transit Authority (NRTA) through its consultant AECOM of Rocky Hill, CT is conducting a study to determine the feasibility of year-round bus service. If it is determined that year-round service is both feasible and is a service the community wants and needs, the consultants will then develop service scenarios and an implementation plan that will be publicly presented in February.

“It is crucial that we hear from the public during this process,” said Paula Leary, NRTA Administrator, “If the public does not voice its need and desire for the NRTA to expand its fixed route bus service known as the Wave, then the process will end. This is the time to provide your input”.

Open-House Style Interactive Public Workshops will be held at the Boys & Girls Club on Monday, January 11th from 6:30 p.m. to 8:30 p.m. and Tuesday, January 12th from 11:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. This style of public workshop enables people to drop in at any time during the workshop hours and provide input at various interactive stations.
